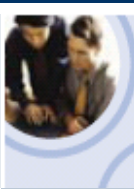

## WORKSHOP DESCRIPTIONS

**Austroads Guide to Traffic Engineering Practice Part 3- Traffic Studies:** A two day workshop based on the Austroads *GTEP3* relating to the latest practices applying to data collection and analysis for use in traffic studies.

**Austroads Guide to Traffic Engineering Practice Part 4 - Investigation and Treatment of Crash Locations:** A two day workshop based on the Austroads *GTEP4* that covers the latest practice applying to the investigation and treatment of crash locations.

**Austroads Guide to Traffic Engineering Practice Part 7 - Traffic Signals:** An instructional two day workshop based on the Austroads *GTEP7* Guide. This workshop covers signal phasing & timing and includes local expert practitioners.

**Austroads Guide to Traffic Management Part 8 - Local Area Traffic Management:** An instructional two day workshop based on the background material supporting the new edition of the Austroads *Guide to Traffic Management Part 8*. It covers material relating to best practice techniques, available resources, design principles, device selection, special needs of different road users, legal issues and a case study syndicate exercise to provide hands-on experience applying the latest best practice. Please note this workshop now replaced the GTEP Part 10: LATM workshop.

**Austroads Guide to Traffic Management Part 11 - Parking:** An instructional two day workshop based on the new Austroads *Guide to Traffic Management Part 11*. It discusses parking demand and supply and provides a parking policy framework, including implementation of on-street and off-street parking, parking controls in urban centres, parking on rural roads, park-and-ride facilities, and electronic parking guidance systems.

**Basic Geometric Road Design:** A three day hands-on workshop to provide new graduates, draftpersons and technicians with a practical understanding of basic geometric road design.

**Implementing a Safe System:** The aim of this two day workshop is to teach participants what is involved in developing successful policies to advance road safety.

**Local Skid Resistance Strategies:** An instructional workshop based on the current Austroads Guide. This is a one day workshop on developing effective local strategies in managing road surface skid resistance across a network.

**Managing Road Pavement Assets:** This workshop was previously known as Road Network Management. These workshops are based on the extensive research and consulting work undertaken by ARRB and the various studies and guides issued by Austroads.

**Parking –Technology, Audit & Shopping Centres:** This one-day course is designed to concentrate on four areas of parking operations: audit, technology, shopping centres and wayfinding. These topics complement each other and are of relevance to all parking facility owners and operators, especially those looking to upgrade or evaluate their services and profitability.

**Road Maintenance by Contract:** A one day workshop on road maintenance delivery in the new millennium, after fifteen years of change where to now?

**Speed Limits:** A one day workshop on the speed limit setting process detailed in Part 4 – Speed Controls of the Queensland Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices.

**Speed Limits and Speed Management:** A one day workshop based on the Austroads *Guide to Road Safety Part 3 – Speed Limits and Speed Management* and *Guide to Traffic Management Part 5 – Road Management*.
